Submit your request by June 20, 2026; after this date, your request might not be able to be accommodated.

Alt-Text and Image Descriptions

We encourage all presenters to include Alt Text and/or Image Descriptions for all images used in digital spaces.

Presenters have been provided with an ICA/Incheon branded slide template to observe for font hierarchy and color contrast ADA standards.

Accessibility at the Songdo ConvensiA

Accessible and Companion Seating

Both of this year's venues offer "ballroom" style seating at events. Therefore, chairs can be moved to accommodate needs, including wheelchairs. Notify a volunteer or usher, and we will accommodate you.

We always provide companion seating options also. Let an Usher or Volunteer know if you would benefit from accessible seating options at either the Art Center Incheon or the Songdo ConvensiA for an event. Volunteers and Ushers are stationed at door entry points and will be wearing a red volunteer shirt.

Service Animals

Legitimate service animals are welcomed at the Songdo ConvensiA. Working service animals are legally permitted entry alongside visitors with disabilities. Under South Korean disability law, all public facilities, including convention centers, *are required to allow certified service dogs that are wearing official harnesses and identification.*

A service animal is any dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, including a physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual or other mental disability. Other species of animals, whether wild or domestic, trained or untrained, are not considered service animals.

A service animal can be excluded from the Songdo ConvensiA if its presence interferes with legitimate safety requirements of Songdo ConvensiA. *A service animal must be under the handler's control through voice commands, hand signals or other effective means.*

Assisted Hearing

No assisted hearing services are provided at Songdo ConvensiA. Should you need accommodations, please contact us in advance.

Changing Facilities

The venue provides large bathrooms with handicapped accessibility and baby changing facilities in every location. Family bathrooms are also on site. Large performance spaces have dressing rooms available backstage.

Nursing Room

For your convenience Songdo ConvensiA has multiple nursing stations. They can be found by the first floor bathrooms and close to information centers. Exact locations are on the map.

Facilities for Visitors With Visual Impairments

- This facility is highly accessible for visitors with visual impairments.
- Barrier-Free navigation using smart MICE technology.
- The facility uses tactile paving with indicator blocks installed at key approaches, including all entryways nearby Central Park pathways to the main entrance.
- All rooms, halls and toilets are signposted in large print and Braille.
- Ushers or Volunteers are available to assist visitors to their event or seat if required.
- All elevators have Braille buttons.

Fire and Emergency

- Songdo ConvensiA employees are fully trained in evacuation procedures for those with limited mobility.
- In the event of an evacuation, you will be escorted to the nearest safe space by staff of Songdo ConvensiA.
- Safe spaces for customers with limited mobility are located throughout the venue.
- If you have a service dog, the dog should also go to the safe space.

First Aid / Medical Assistance

- Songdo ConvensiA Security officers are trained in CPR and first aid.
- At Songdo ConvensiA, defibrillators are located in the security offices, in the main lobby of all large halls, and the main entrance.
- All event spaces and performance venues in Songdo ConvensiA are wheelchair accessible without stairs.

Special Effects

- Some events at Songdo ConvensiA may involve pyrotechnics, strobe lighting and other special effects. Please contact The International Clarinet Association for details on any special effects expected at the event you are attending.

Restrooms for People with Disabilities

- Toilets for people with disabilities are located throughout the venue. Exact locations can be found on the map.

Wheelchair Access

- All meeting spaces are wheelchair accessible.
- At least one companion seat is available next to the wheelchair user's space.
- For conferences, the wheelchair spaces and companion seats can be booked through edo@clarinet.org or deia@clarinet.org

Low Sensory Spaces

- The Songdo ConvensiA has many spaces both inside and outside of the facility that can provide a reprieve from the sounds of ClarinetFest®. Parking

Indoor and outdoor fully automated paid parking lots are available. Discounts are available for compact cars, electric/low emission vehicles, vehicles of persons with disabilities, vehicles registered under persons of national merit.

- Parking Capacity: 1,157 total spaces (355 ground, 802 underground)
- Parking Fees and Rates:
 - First 30 minutes: 600 KRW
 - Each additional 30 minutes: 600 KRW
 - Daily maximum: 6,000 KRW
 - Large vehicles (Buses, trucks over 2.5 tons): 1,200 KRW per 30 minutes (Daily max 12,000 KRW)
- Dedicated charging stations are available for electric vehicles.
- There does not appear to be easily available or accessible street parking by this venue.
- There are no in-and- out privileges.
- Songdo ConvensiA does not provide free parking areas for event attendees, exhibitors, contractors or licensee's staff. A limited number of parking passes may be issued as a part of the license agreement.
